WEATHER SAFETY



Nebraska is known for its extreme weather changes. During our summer programs at Sullivan Hills Camp, we have a lot of sunshine and blue skies, but we aren't immune to less friendly conditions. We use Weather Defender, a state-of-

the-art weather tracking program, to keep campers safe. This program enables us to monitor conditions every hour of the summer. Sullivan Hills Camp has belowground shelter facilities. Should severe weather systems reach camp, we are prepared to alter schedules and will update you via email on any developments. Using Weather Defender will help us be well prepared for any extreme weather that may happen.

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT

All registrations will be done at SullivanHills.org/Registration through the online UltraCamp software. Parents/guardians of first-time campers need to create an account and fill out the necessary information, and parents/guardians of returning campers need to update some information as well.
